Parishioners, beginning of Lent is only days away with Ash Wednesday this week. Although it is not a Holy Day of Obligation, it is, of course, "right and just" to attend Mass and receive the ashes. Our parish offers four Mass times: 7:30am, 9:15am, 12 noon (with members of our parish school community), and 7:00pm. During Lent, we will try to create as many opportunities as possible for you to grow in faith. Please take note of our "Lenten Lectures" this year which will focus on exploring the lives of certain "controversial Catholics" those who dared to challenge the status quo. We will also

have Stations of the Cross led by some wonderful parishioners on Fridays. There will be a retreat day for all parishioners at the Shrine of Mercy at Penrose Park on **Saturday 9th March** (a bus has been booked, please see further details inside.) Following the great success of our Advent women's retreat days, we are organising our first men's Lenten retreat day, which will take place on **Saturday 23rd March**. ASH WEDNESDAY: 14 February is Ash Wednesday which starts the Season of Lent. Masses will be: 7:30 am; 9:15 am; 12 noon School Mass with Years 3 - 6) and 7:00 pm.

MUSIC AND NEW CHOIR(S): We are blessed to have four well -attended Weekend Masses in this parish. In 2024, it would be great to revitalise the musical life of our parish, especially at the 5pm Vigil, 9:30am, and 5:00pm Sunday (7:30am will remain our "Low (quiet) Mass", which can be equally as beautiful). Having Daniel with us is a great blessing as he is well-versed in the musical tradition of the Church and can help us ensure that our hymns are (1) seasonal and suitable; (2) approved by the Australian Catholic Bishops Conference. As a precursor to this, we would like to form one united choir to sing during the Easter Triduum. If you have an interest in the musical life of the parish, or are blessed to be even remotely talented in this regard, then, please get involved. I have heard that there are a group of ten men from the "Men's Group" who have already formed a new choir. Thank you for this initiative and thank you to all those who already and so generously help us to "pray twice" through music. Our first united gathering will be on Sunday 25th **February** at 10:30am (following the 9:30am Mass).
