Tuesday, 2 April - Tuesday within the Octave of Easter

it will raise them up for ever; Alleluia!

Responsorial Psalm:

(3 Verses)

(R.) The earth is full of the goodness of the Lord.

The Gospel Acclamation & Verse:

Alleluia!

Communion Antiphon:

If you have risen with Christ, seek the things that are above,
where Christ is seated at the right hand of God;
mind the things that are above: Alleluia!

Wednesday, 3 April - Wednesday within the Octave of Easter

Entrance Antiphon:

Come, you blessed of my Father;
receive the kingdom prepared for you
from the foundation of the world; Alleluia!

Responsorial Psalm:

(4 Verses)

(R.) Let all who seek the Lord rejoice.

The Gospel Acclamation & Verse:

Alleluia, alleluia!

let us rejoice and be glad.

Alleluia!

Communion Antiphon:

The disciples recognised the Lord Jesus
in the breaking of the bread: Alleluia!

Thursday, 4 April - Thursday within the Octave of Easter

Entrance Antiphon:

They praised in unison your conquering hand, O Lord,
for wisdom opened mouths that were mute
and gave eloquence to the tongues of infants; Alleluia!

Responsorial Psalm:

(3 Verses)

(R.) O Lord our God, how wonderful your name in all the earth!

The Gospel Acclamation & Verse:

Alleluia, alleluia!

let us rejoice and be glad.

Alleluia!

Communion Antiphon:

O chosen people, proclaim the mighty works of Him,
who called you out of darkness into His wonderful light: Alleluia!
