

Dear Parishioners, Fr Greg and I would like to reiterate our gratitude to the many people who contributed to our Holy Week liturgies which were so well attended. We received such positive feedback as to how beautiful and reverent the liturgies were, especially the music and singing for the Triduum. On behalf of the entire parish community, I warmly congratulate the 18 people who will have received the sacraments of initiation this Easter. 16 were received into the Church at the Easter Vigil and 2 more will be received over the coming weeks. It is such an encouraging sign of the grace of the Holy Spirit at work in the parish community. Yet as Fr Greg and I like to emphasise, we must continue to pray and work for the continued evangelisation of the people of Gymea, that many more may discover Truth and Mercy in Jesus Christ.

This weekend we celebrate 'Divine Mercy Sunday' as part of the Second Sunday of Easter. The Divine Mercy devotion has been a tsunami of grace for so many around the world, and Fr Greg and I are always surprised at how

many people are drawn to the message of Divine Mercy given by Our Lord to St. Faustina, especially when we live in a culture that is often so merciless and unforgiving. The parish will offer devotions in honour of the Feast of Divine Mercy; commencing at 2.30pm with a short talk and then Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, veneration of the Image, the Divine Mercy Chaplet, the Rosary and silent adoration. DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY:




