Communion Antiphon:

Behold, a Virgin shall conceive and bear a Son;
and His Name will be called Emmanuel: Alleluia!

Tuesday, 9 April - Tuesday of the 2nd week of Easter

Entrance Antiphon:

Let us rejoice and be glad and give glory to God,
for the Lord our God the Almighty reigns; Alleluia!

Responsorial Psalm:

(3 Verses)

(R.) The Lord is King; He is robed in Majesty .

The Gospel Acclamation & Verse:

Alleluia, alleluia!

The Son of Man must be lifted up
so that all who believe in Him
may have Eternal Life.

Alleluia!

Communion Antiphon:

The Christ had to suffer and rise from the dead,
and so enter into His glory: Alleluia!

Wednesday, 10 April - Wednesday of the 2nd week of Easter

Entrance Antiphon:

I will praise you, Lord, among the nations;

I will tell of your Name to my kin; Alleluia!

Responsorial Psalm:

(4 Verses)

(R.) The Lord hears the cry of the poor.

The Gospel Acclamation & Verse:

Alleluia, alleluia!

God loved the world so much, He gave us His only Son,
that all who believe in Him might have Eternal Life.

Alleluia!

Communion Antiphon:

“I have chosen you from the world:” says the Lord,
“And have appointed you to go and bear fruit,
fruit that will last.” Alleluia!

Thursday, 11 April - Thursday of the 2nd week of Easter
The Memorial of Saint Stanislaus (bishop, Martyr)

Entrance Antiphon:

This Saint went as far as death,

handing over his life to destruction for the work of Christ; Alleluia!

Responsorial Psalm:

(3 Verses)

(R.) The Lord hears the cry of the poor.

The Gospel Acclamation & Verse:

Alleluia, alleluia!

You believe in me, Thomas, because you have seen me;
happy are those who have not seen me, but still believe!

Alleluia!

Communion Antiphon:

“Whoever loses his life for the sake of the Gospel
will save it;” says the Lord: Alleluia!
