**The Feast of Saint Philip & Saint James - Apostles (Martyrs)**

**Entrance Antiphon:**

These are the holy men whom the Lord chose in His own perfect love;  
to them He gave eternal glory; Alleluia!

**Responsorial Psalm:** (2 Verses)

**(R.)** Their message goes out through all the earth.

**The Gospel Acclamation & Verse:**

**Alleluia, alleluia!**

**"I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life;" says the Lord;**  
**"Philip, whoever sees me sees the Father."**

**Alleluia!**

**Communion Antiphon:**

'Lord, show us the Father, and that will be enough for us.'  
'Whoever has seen me, Philip, has seen the Father also.' Alleluia!

**Saturday, 4 May - Saturday of the 5th week of Easter**

**Entrance Antiphon:**

You have been buried with Christ in Baptism,  
through which you also rose again by faith in the working of God,  
who raised Him from the dead; Alleluia!

**Responsorial Psalm:** (3 Verses)

**(R.)** Let all the earth cry out to God with joy.

**The Gospel Acclamation & Verse:**

**Alleluia, alleluia!**

If then you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above,  
where Christ is seated at the right hand of God.

**Alleluia!**

**Communion Antiphon:**

"Father, I pray for them, that they may be one in us,  
so that the world may believe it was you who sent me:"  
says the Lord. Alleluia!

**Entrance Antiphon:**

Here is a wise virgin, from among the number of the prudent,  
who went forth with lighted lamp to meet Christ; Alleluia!

**Responsorial Psalm:** (3 Verses)

**(R.)** Not to us, O Lord, but to your name give the glory.

**The Gospel Acclamation & Verse:**

**Alleluia, alleluia!**

The Holy Spirit will teach you all things  
and remind you of all I have said to you.

**Alleluia!**

**Communion Antiphon:**

If we walk in the light, as God is in the light,  
then we have fellowship with one another,  
and the blood of His Son Jesus Christ cleanses us from all sin: Alleluia!

**Tuesday, 30 April - Tuesday of the 5th week of Easter**  
**Pope Saint Pius V**

**Entrance Antiphon:**

Sing praise to our God, all you who fear God, both small and great,  
for now salvation and strength have come,  
and the power of His Christ; Alleluia!

**Responsorial Psalm:** (3 Verses)

**(R.)** Your friends tell the glory of your kingship, Lord.

**The Gospel Acclamation & Verse:**

**Alleluia, alleluia!**

Christ had to suffer and to rise from the dead,  
and so enter into His glory.

**Alleluia!**

**Communion Antiphon:**

If we have died with Christ,  
we believe that we shall also live with Christ: Alleluia!

**Wednesday, 1 May - Wednesday of the 5th week of Easter**  
**Saint Joseph the Worker**

**Entrance Antiphon:**

Let my mouth be filled with your praise, that I may sing aloud;  
my lips shall shout for joy, when I sing to you; Alleluia!

**Responsorial Psalm:** (3 Verses)

**(R.)** Let us go rejoicing to the house of the Lord.

**The Gospel Acclamation & Verse:**

**Alleluia, alleluia!**

“Live in me and let me live in you;” says the Lord;  
“My branches bear much fruit.”

**Alleluia!**

**Communion Antiphon:**

The Lord has risen and shone his light upon us,  
whom He has redeemed by His Blood: Alleluia!

**Thursday, 2 May - Thursday of the 5th week of Easter**  
**The Memorial of Saint Athanasius** (*bishop, doctor*)

**Entrance Antiphon:**

In the midst of the Church he opened his mouth,  
and the Lord filled him with the spirit of wisdom and understanding  
and clothed him in a robe of glory; Alleluia!

**Responsorial Psalm:** (3 Verses)

**(R.)** Proclaim His marvellous deeds to all the nations.

**The Gospel Acclamation & Verse:**

**Alleluia, alleluia!**

“My sheep listen to my voice;” says the Lord:  
“I know them, and they follow me.”

**Alleluia!**

**Communion Antiphon:**

No one can lay a foundation other than the one that is there,  
namely, Jesus Christ: Alleluia!
